Genetic evaluation program conducted by the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service to allow cattle producers the opportunity to receive feedback information on the feedlot performance and carcass merit of the calves they produce.

Rules to Participate:

- Steers only – 5 head minimum
- 45-day OQBN Preconditioning
- Weaning deadline: September 29
- \$25 entry fee per producer group
- Steers remain property of consignor
- Expenses are financed to end of the test & deducted from final payment
- Deliver steers to feedyard Nov 13-14
